

Notification of Gift of Securities In-Kind

Brain Tumour Foundation of Canada is grateful for your gift of securities. Under current tax regulations, your donation of publicly traded securities is exempt from capital gains tax only when you transfer the securities in-kind.

A charitable donation receipt for income tax purposes will be issued based on the fair market value of the securities on the date (closing price) the securities are received into Brain Tumour Foundation of Canada's brokerage account.
