

- 1 Morning nausea and vomiting
- 2 Frequent headaches
- 3 Dizziness, unsteadiness, head tilt

- 4 Visual disturbance such as double or blurred vision

Recognizing the most common signs and symptoms associated with brain tumours can help in early diagnosis and treatment.

- 5 Weakness or paralysis
- 6 Seizures
- 7 Personality changes
- 8 Hearing impairment

Other symptoms to look for include:

- Excessive drinking and urinating
- Early puberty

For infants:

- Loss of development milestones
- Increasing head circumference
