

HIGHLIGHTS

In Ontario, oncology drug access navigators take a number of steps to mitigate delays in treatment access including stockpiling sample supply. enrolling patients in the provincial home care program, accessing the pharmaceutical free supply, and seeing patients early.

NOVA SCOTIA & MANITOBA

In Nova Scotia and Manitoba, patients can access 100% funding via the provincial public plan but must be enrolled with the help of a health professional; it takes time to complete the enrollment and the patient must divulge income and SIN during the process.

NEWFOUNDLAND-LABRADOR

In Newfoundland-Labrador, the provincial formulary is so outdated that the hospital doesn't bother to access the public plan for patients who lack insurance - the hospital just has pharmacies send them the bill.

NORTH WEST TERRITORIES

In the Territories, patients who don't have adequate insurance or public plan coverage can access additional public coverage but must do so through their health care provider.
